I wanted to take a minute and clarify a couple of points as you embark on your work

Because of the significance of the subject matter and its impact on our community's future, the Council agreed to have the meeting at night and to have it covered by Channel 12

In addition, beside the questions regarding infrastructure, questions about quality have to be addressed. In some cases they run together. For instance, when we ask what condition is the Waste Treatment Plant, embedded in that question is not just "does it need to be repaired" but "what does it currently remove?" Are there substances that we know and care about today that we were ignorant of when it was built, i.e., hormones, pharmaceuticals and psychotropic drugs. Therefore, will it need to be modified to address these things?

Even if the water is dumped into the aquifer we need to guard against polluting our aquifer. What are the Federal standards? Are they adequate or were they controlled and shaped by the companies that build treatment plants
