RESOLUTION NO. 10860

RELATING TO WATER AND SEWERS; REPEALING RESOLUTION NUMBER 10838 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH PIMA COUNTY PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE CITY SEWERAGE SYSTEM AND FOR THE DISPOSITION OF TREATED AND RECLAIMED WATER.



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Resolution Number 10838 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. That the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit 1 providing for the transfer of the City's sewerage system and for the disposition of treated and reclaimed water be and hereby is approved.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute said Intergovernmental Agreement and the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized to attest to the same.

SECTION 4. That the various city officers and employees be and they hereby are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.

SECTION 5. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Tucson that this resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
