

**STARTING TO WRITE THE DECEMBER REPORT:  
QUESTIONS FOR THE COMMITTEE TO ADDRESS  
July 23, 2008**

**Purpose:** Within the joint scope of work it states, regarding Phase I A, that the goal would be to determine the current state of **City and County** water, wastewater, and reclaimed systems. Phase I B and Phase I C stipulate, respectively, that an assessment of water resources available to the **service area** and that a synopsis of sustainable water population studies and population ranges are to be provided. The purpose of the proposed survey process is to hone in on points of the presentation that merit emphasis and begin to identify areas where outstanding questions remain.

**Instructions:** Please limit responses to three (3) to five (5) clear statements. Please send responses to staff by email before the next meeting date.

1. What key facts, information and/or issues did you take away from each of the presentations? For example, what were the key points related to:
  - The current state of City and County water, wastewater and reclaimed water infrastructure systems?
  - The planned capacity expansions needed to accommodate the existing and future population of the service areas of Tucson Water and the Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department?
  - The status of current water resource supplies for the City/County Service area?
  - Investments that may be needed in water, wastewater and reclaimed water infrastructure systems to meet the service demands of our existing population, as well as the sustainable future water population?
  - The near term critical factors associated with sharing a stable and sustainable water supply?
2. Given the in depth presentation of (cite presentation title and date), what are the most important and relevant facts, assumptions, or issues to be included in the discussion of values and policies in Phase II?
3. What are the key policy questions to be addressed in Phase II?
